



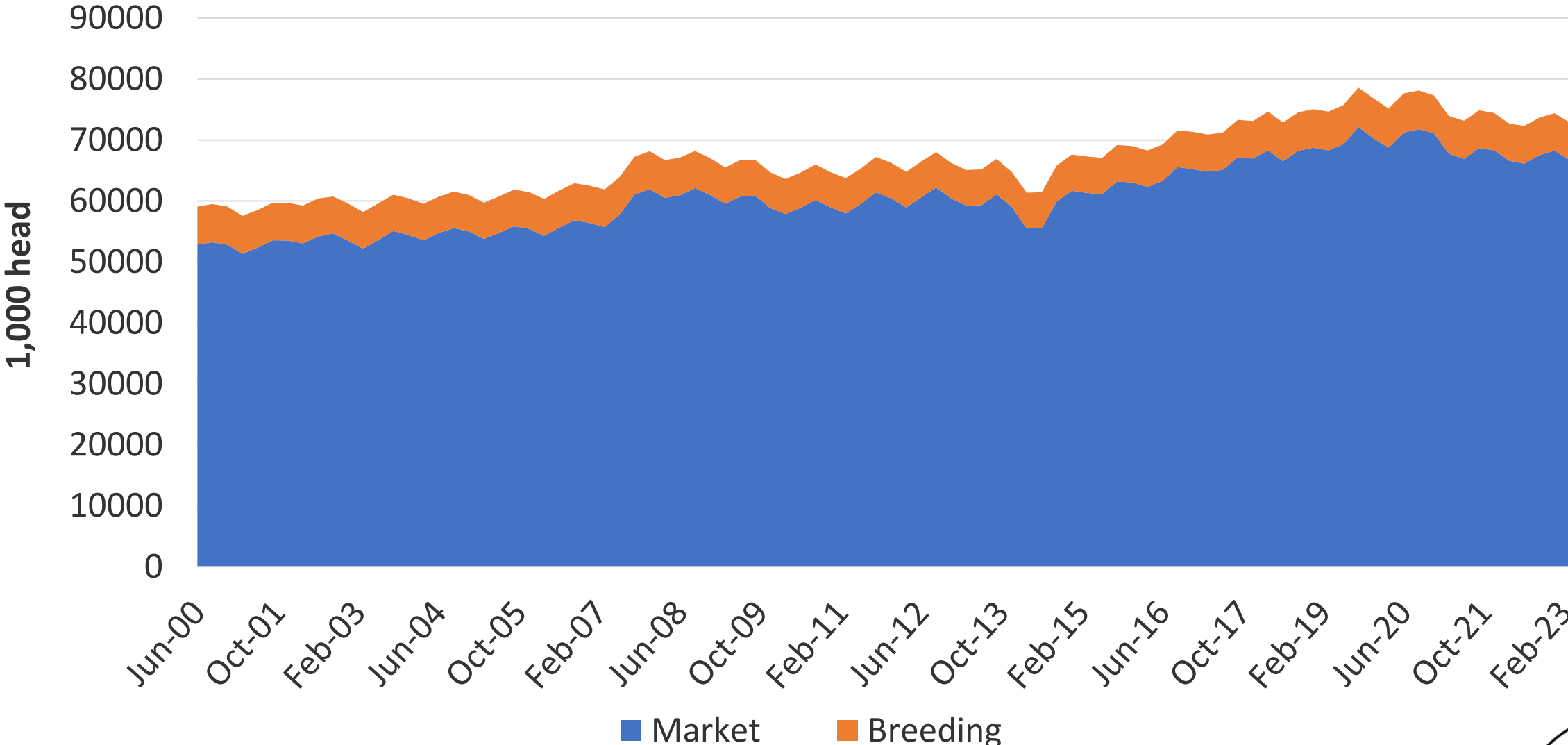

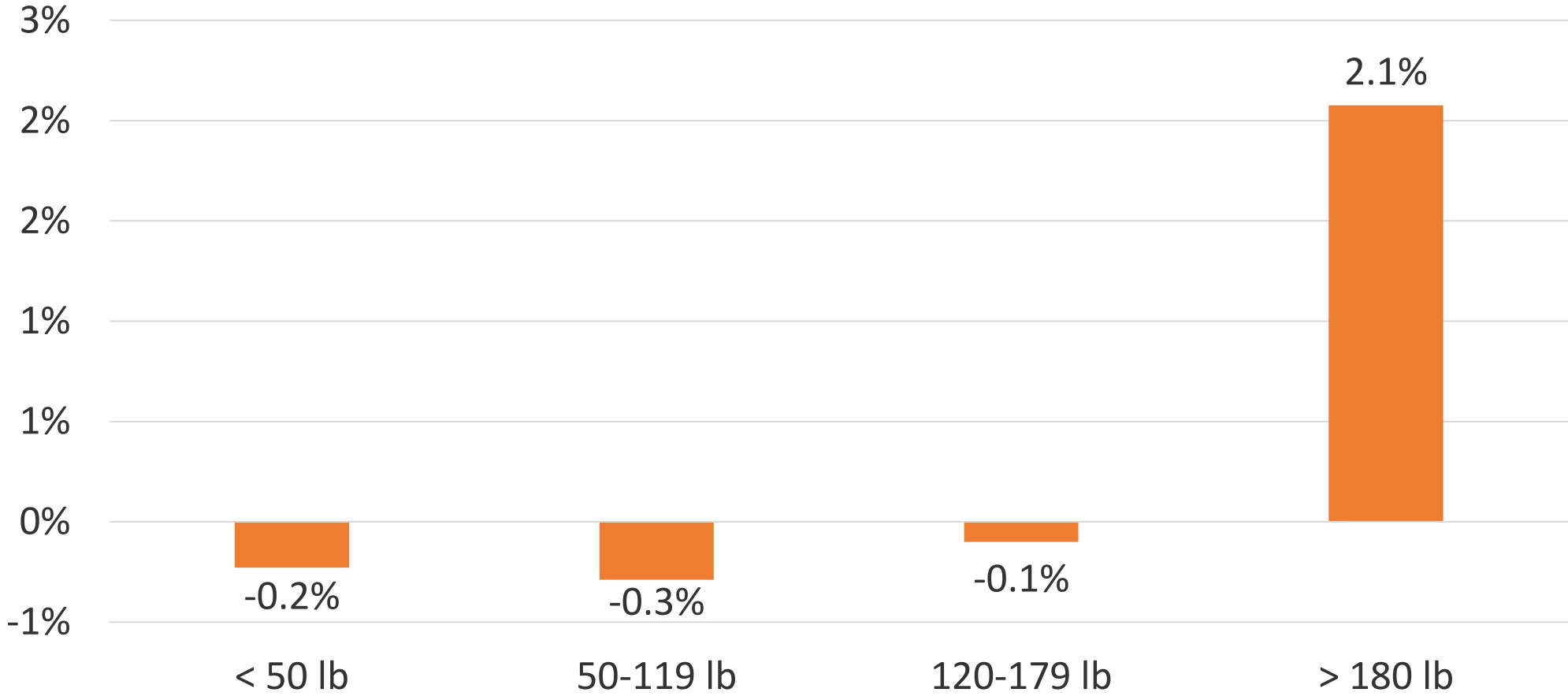
Quarterly U.S. Hogs and Pigs Inventory

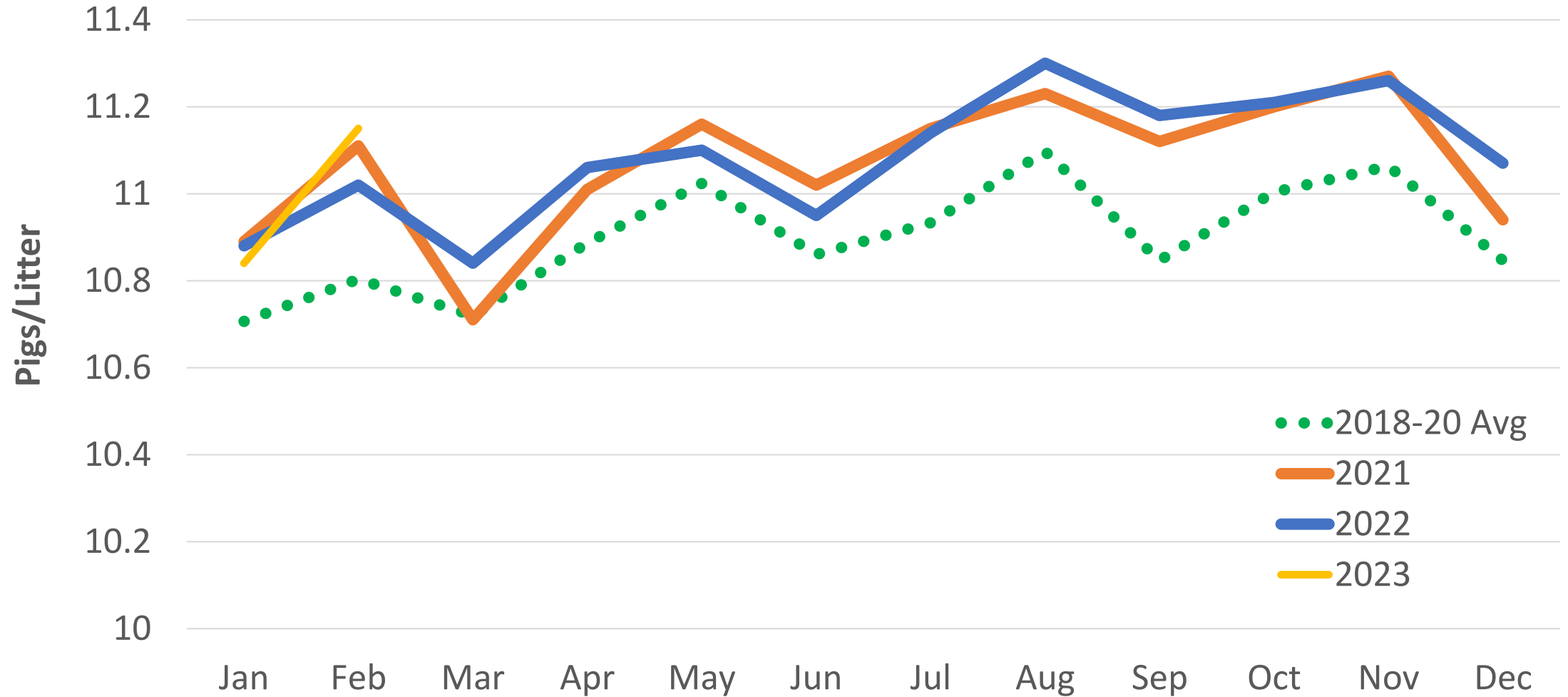
Change in Market Hog Inventory from March 2022 to March 2023, by Weight Class

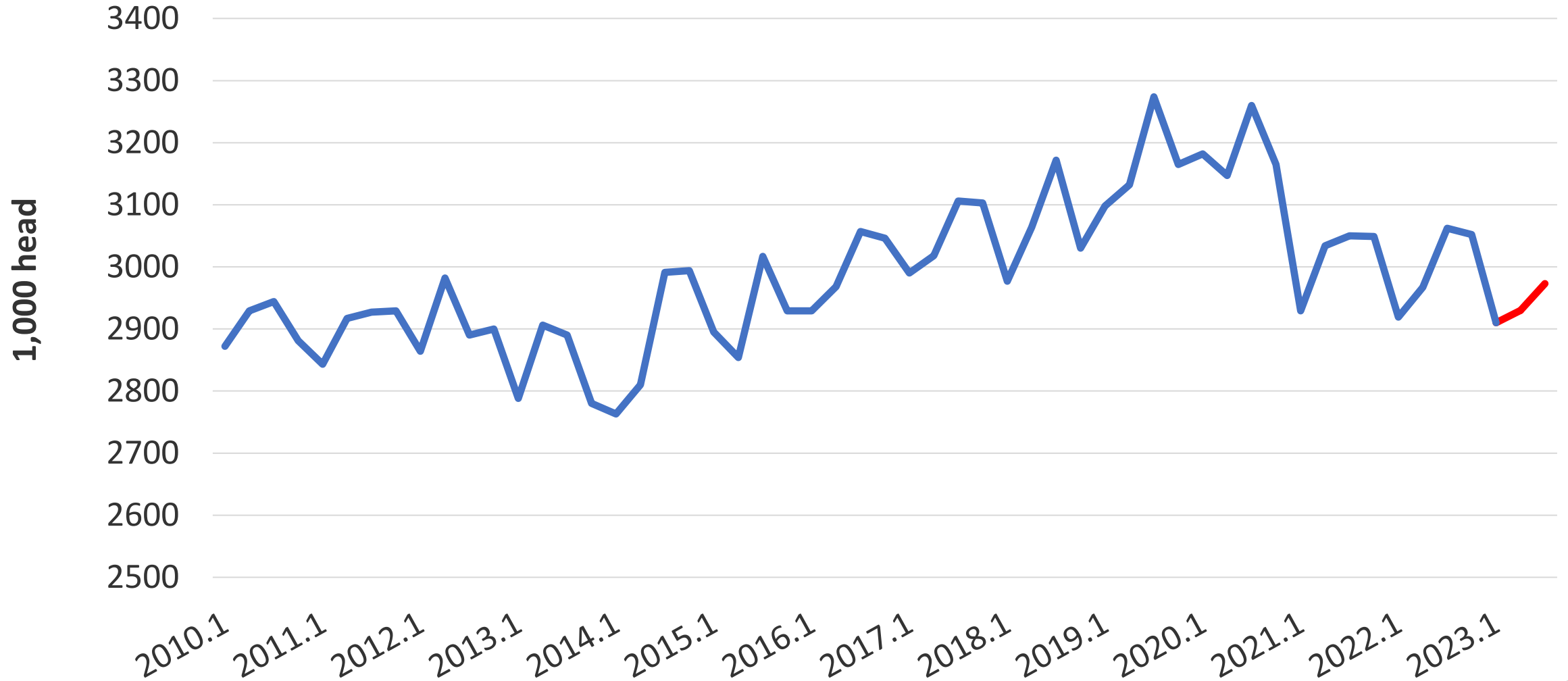
U.S. Average Pigs Saved Per Litter

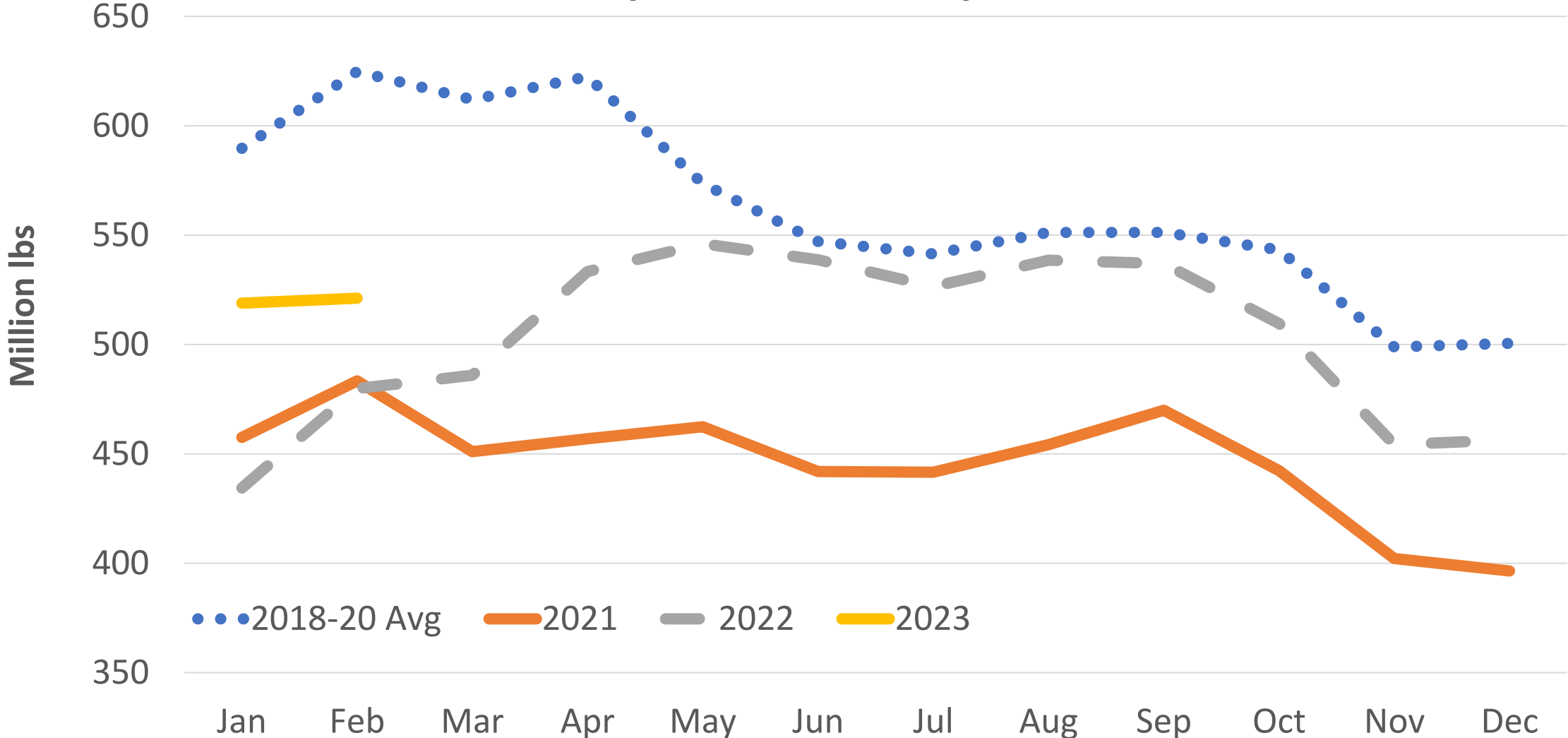
Sows Farrowing

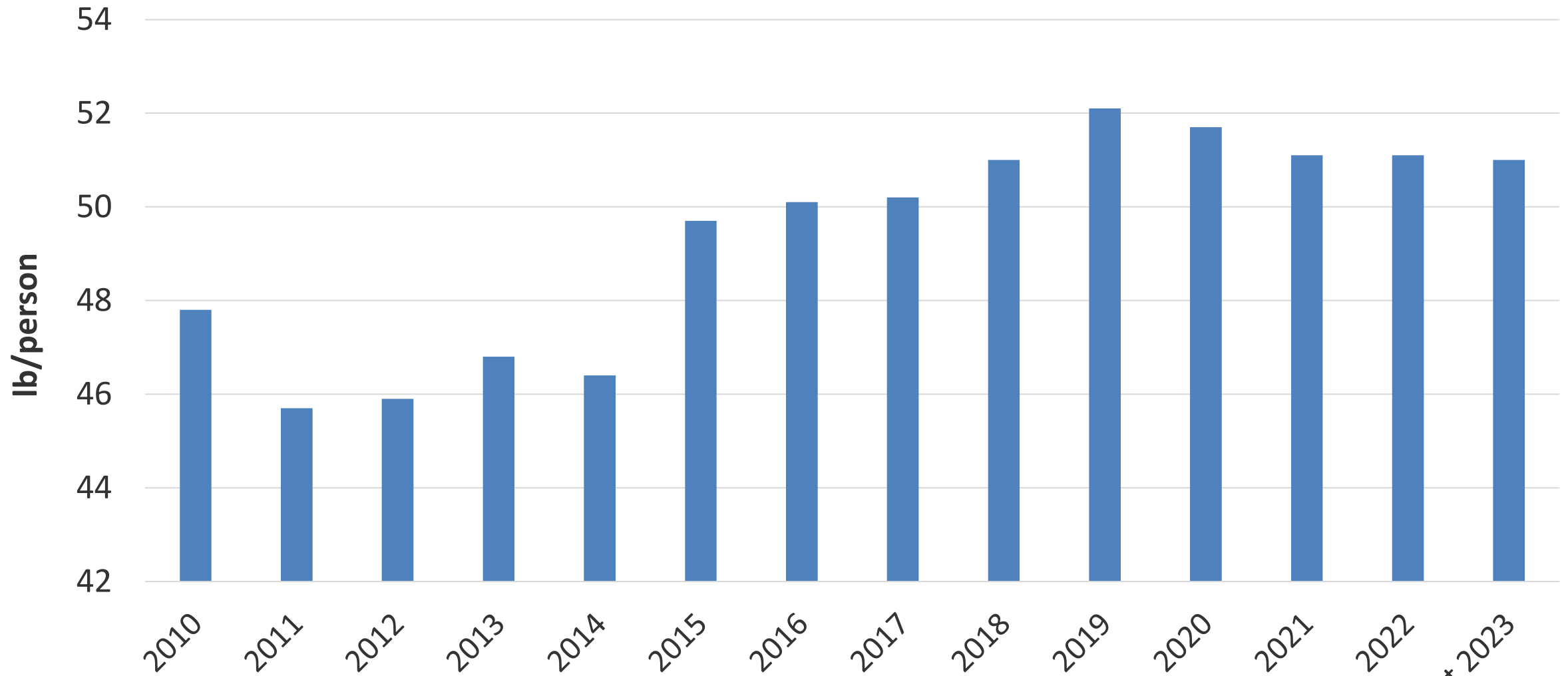
U.S. Frozen Stocks of Pork (End of Month)

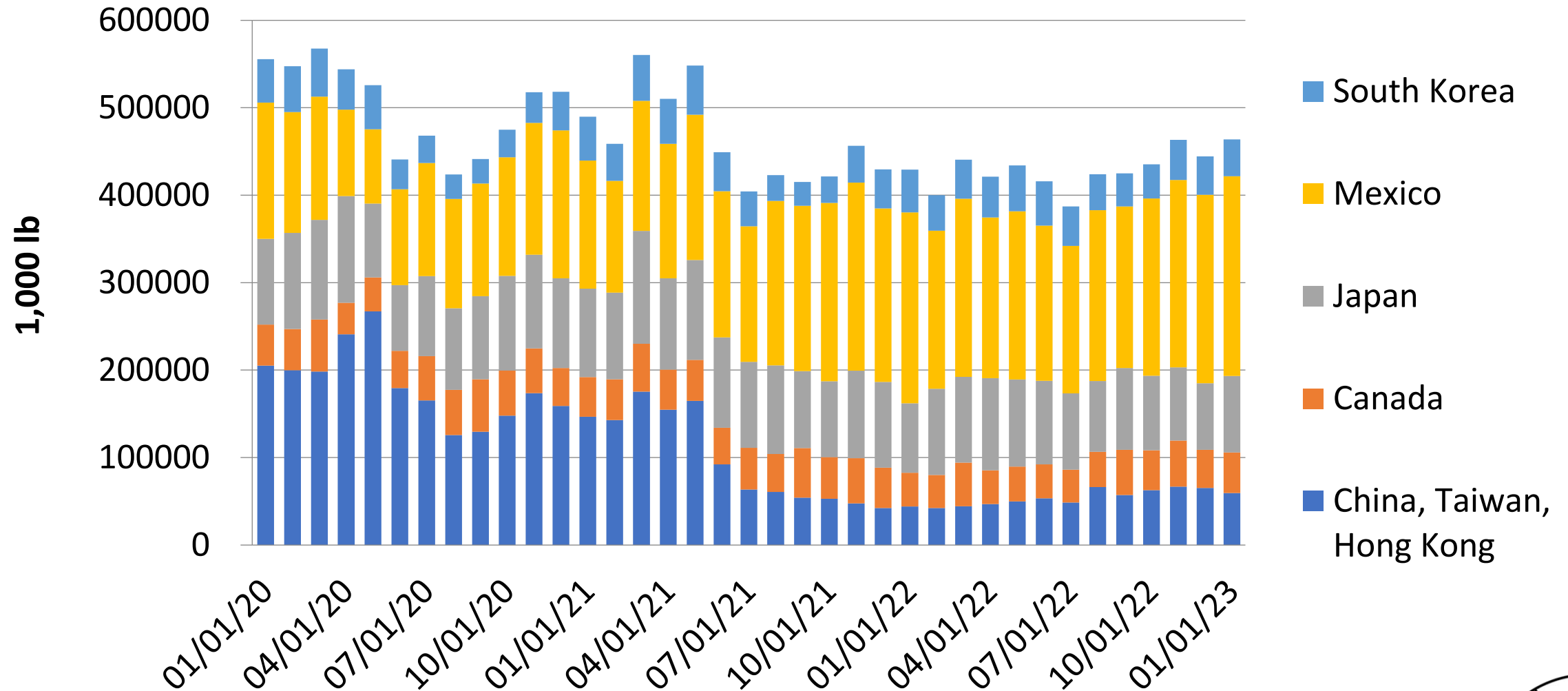
U.S. Annual Per Capita Pork Consumption

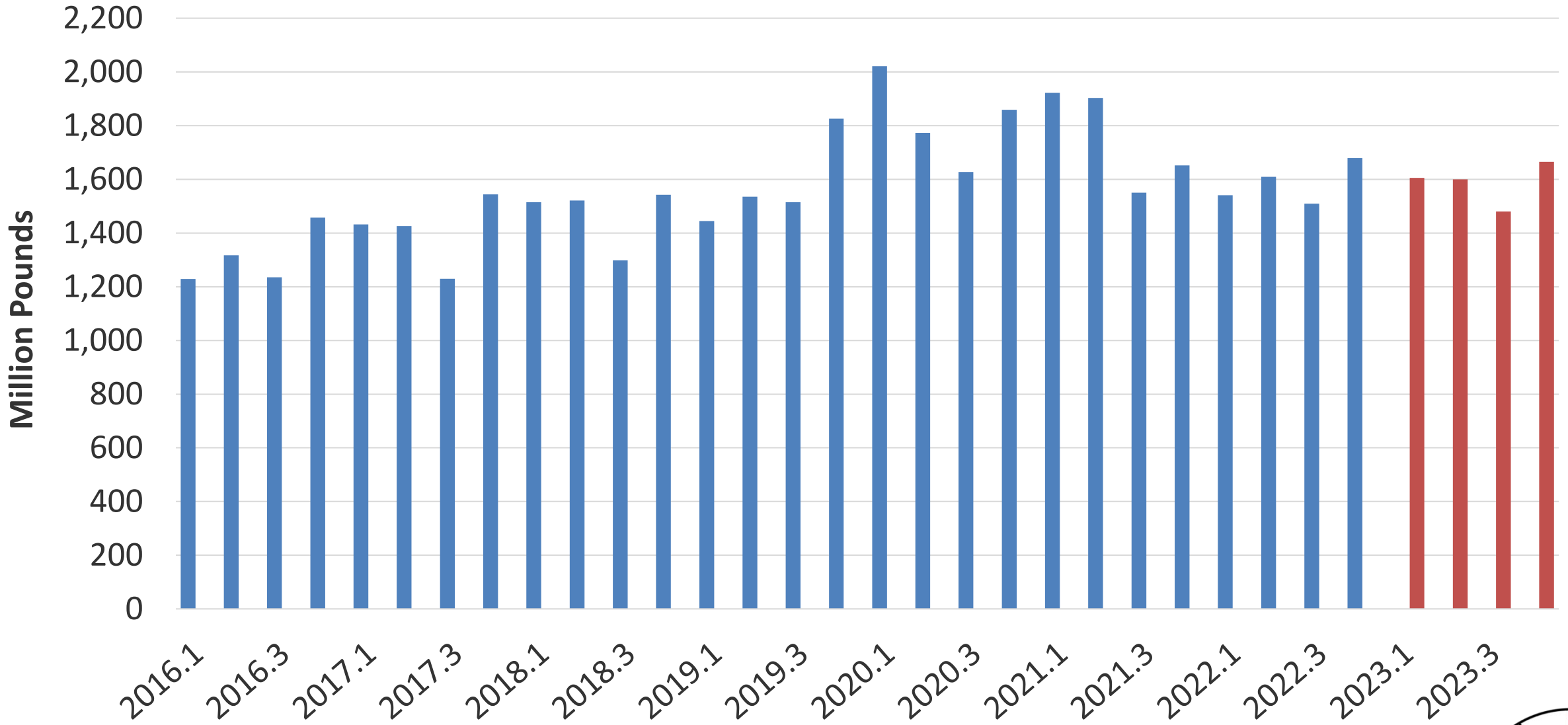
U.S. Pork Exports
