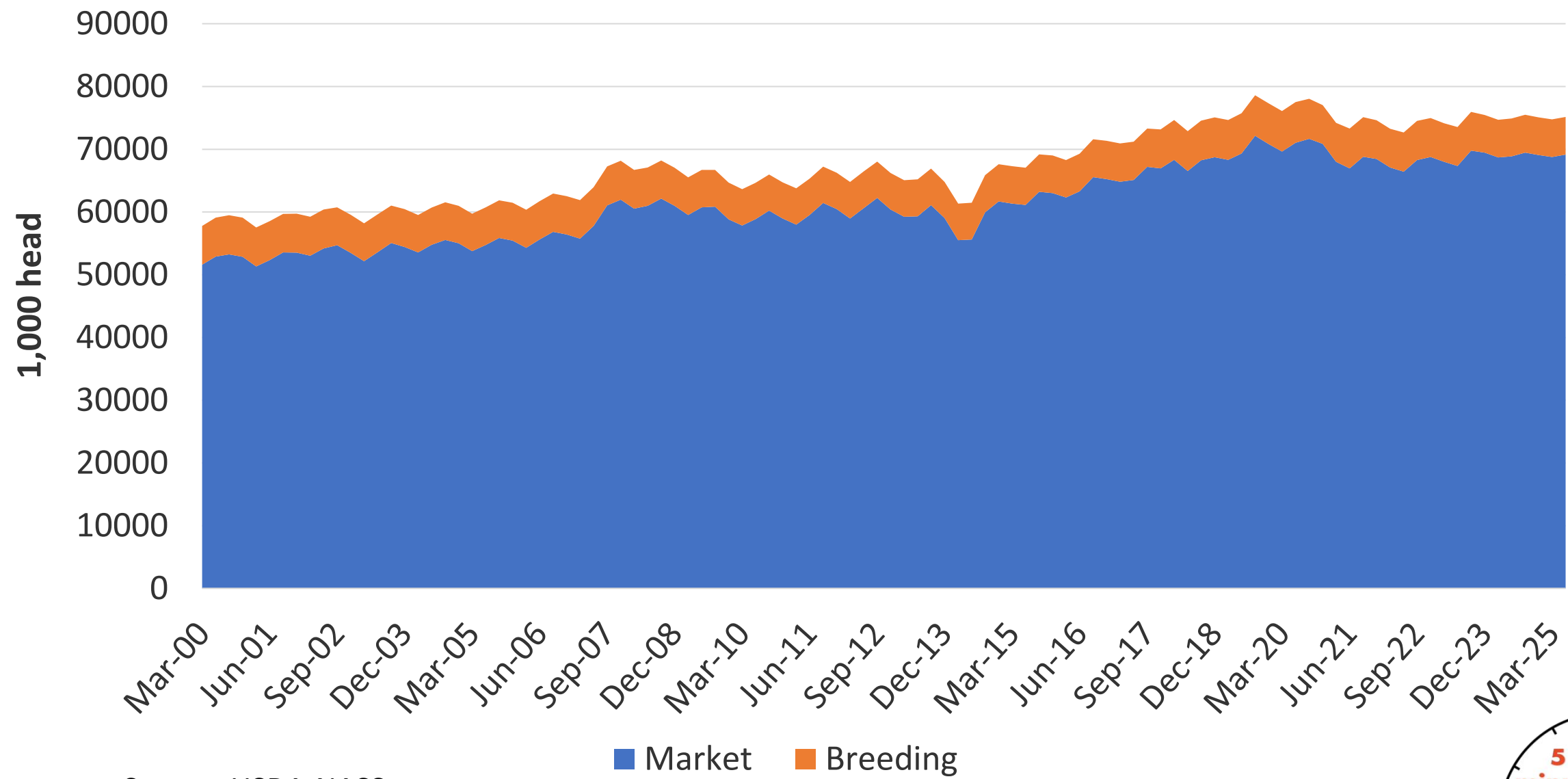

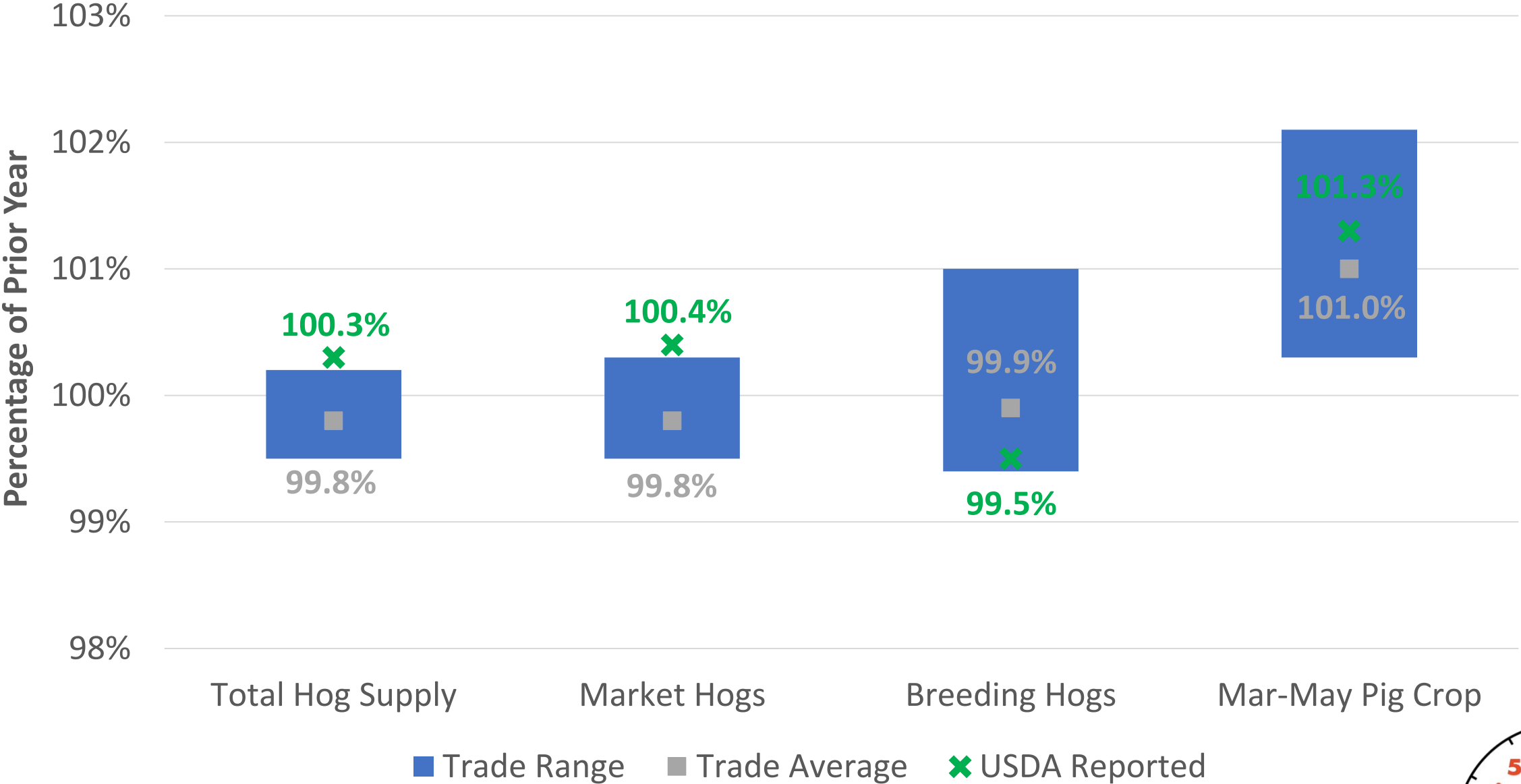
Quarterly U.S. Hogs and Pigs Inventory

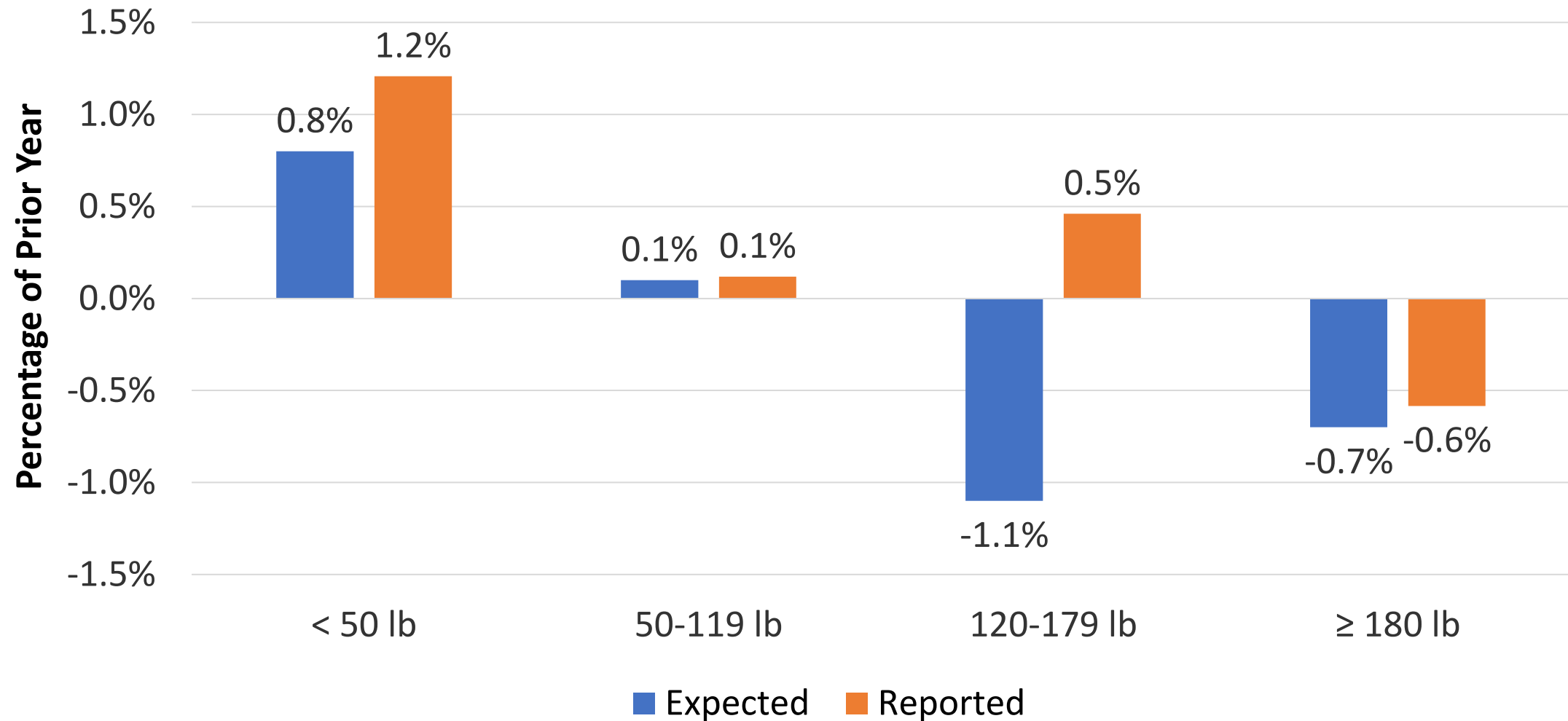
Trade Expectations vs USDA Report

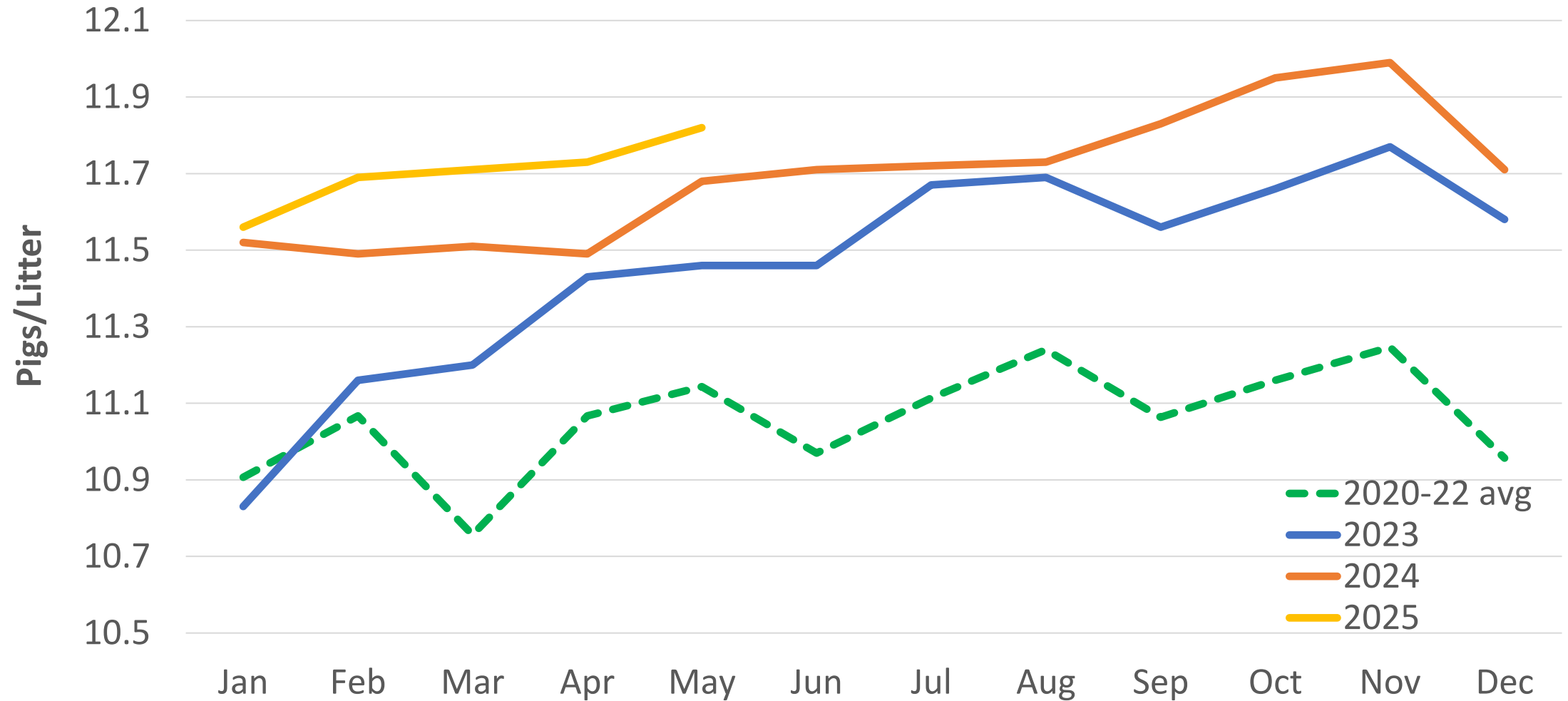
Change in Market Hog Inventory from June 2024 to June 2025, by Weight Class

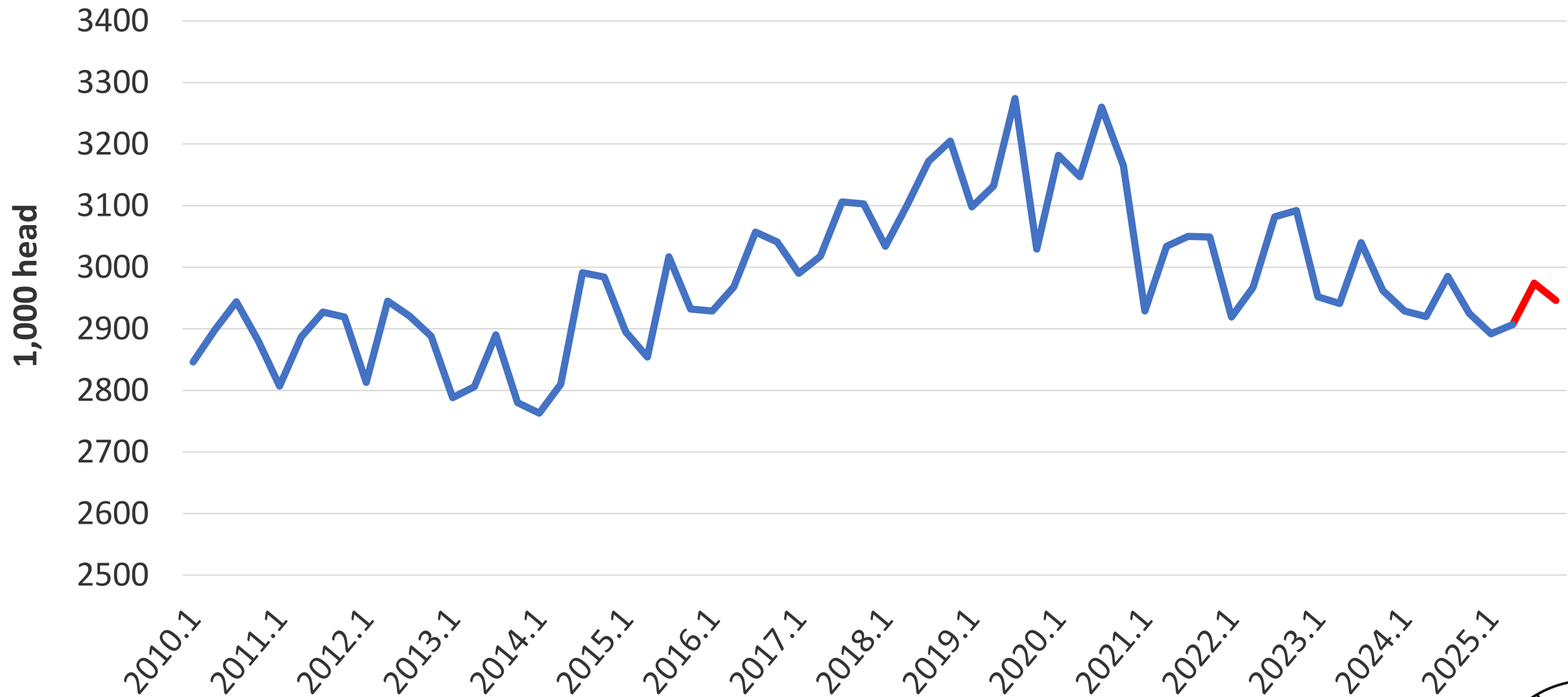
U.S. Average Pigs Saved Per Litter

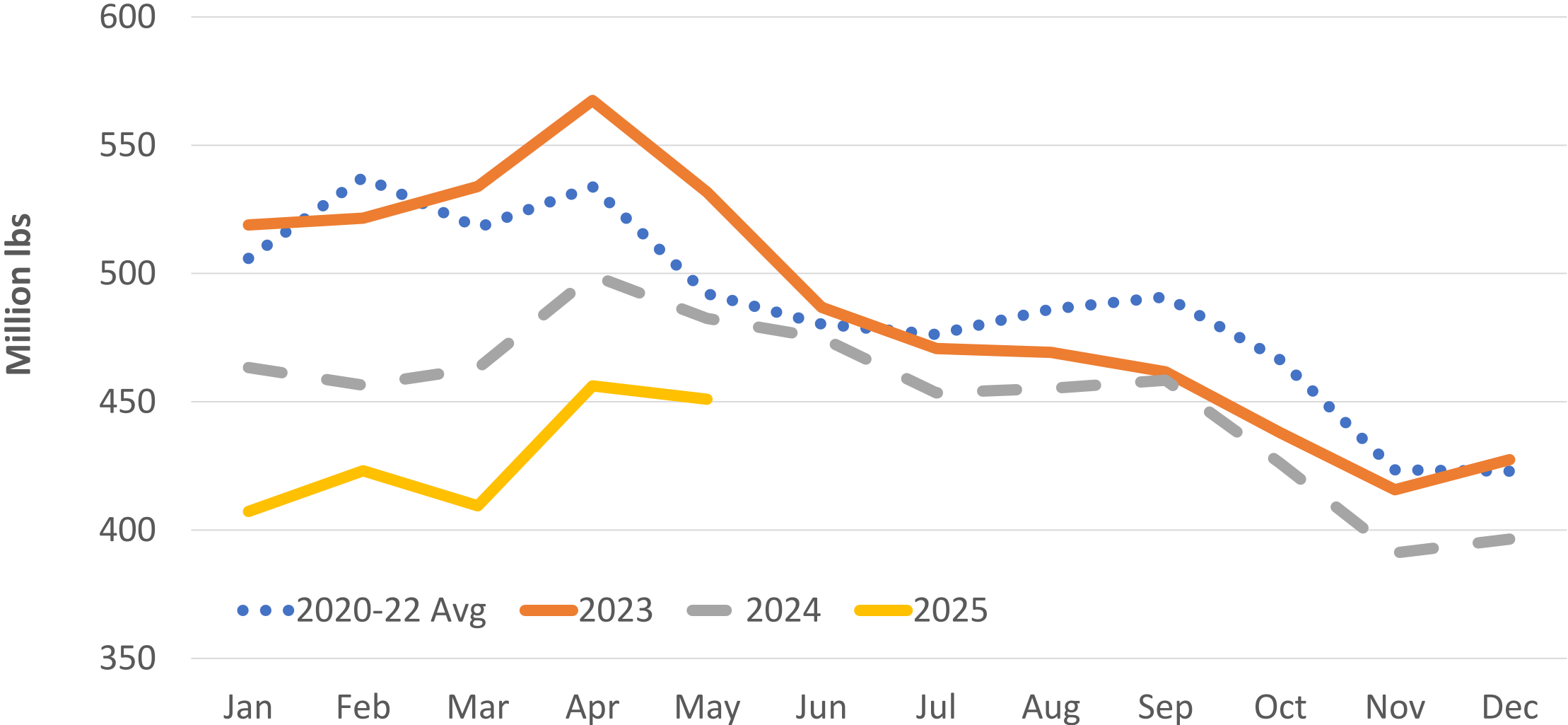

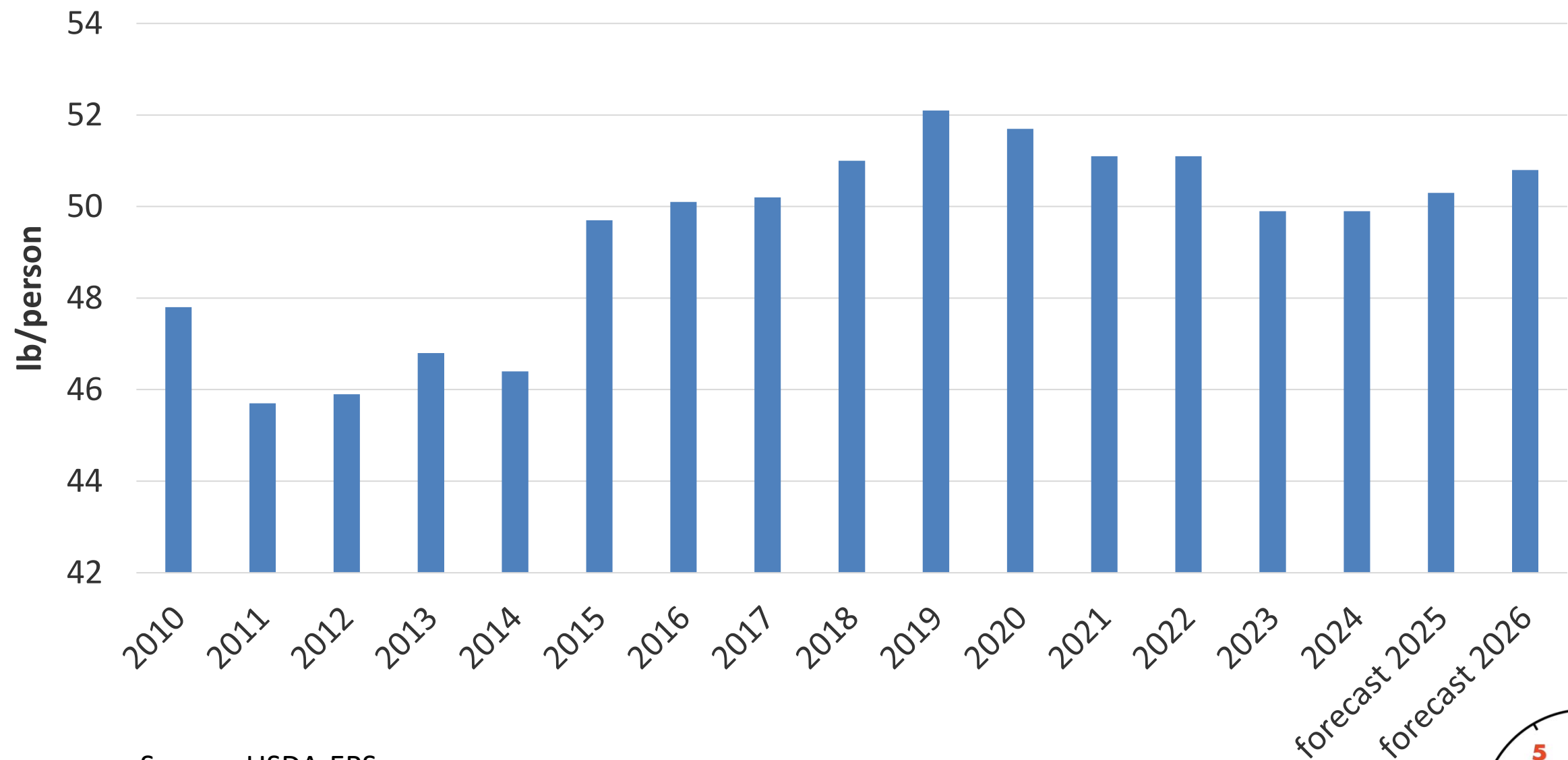
U.S. Frozen Stocks of Pork (End of Month)

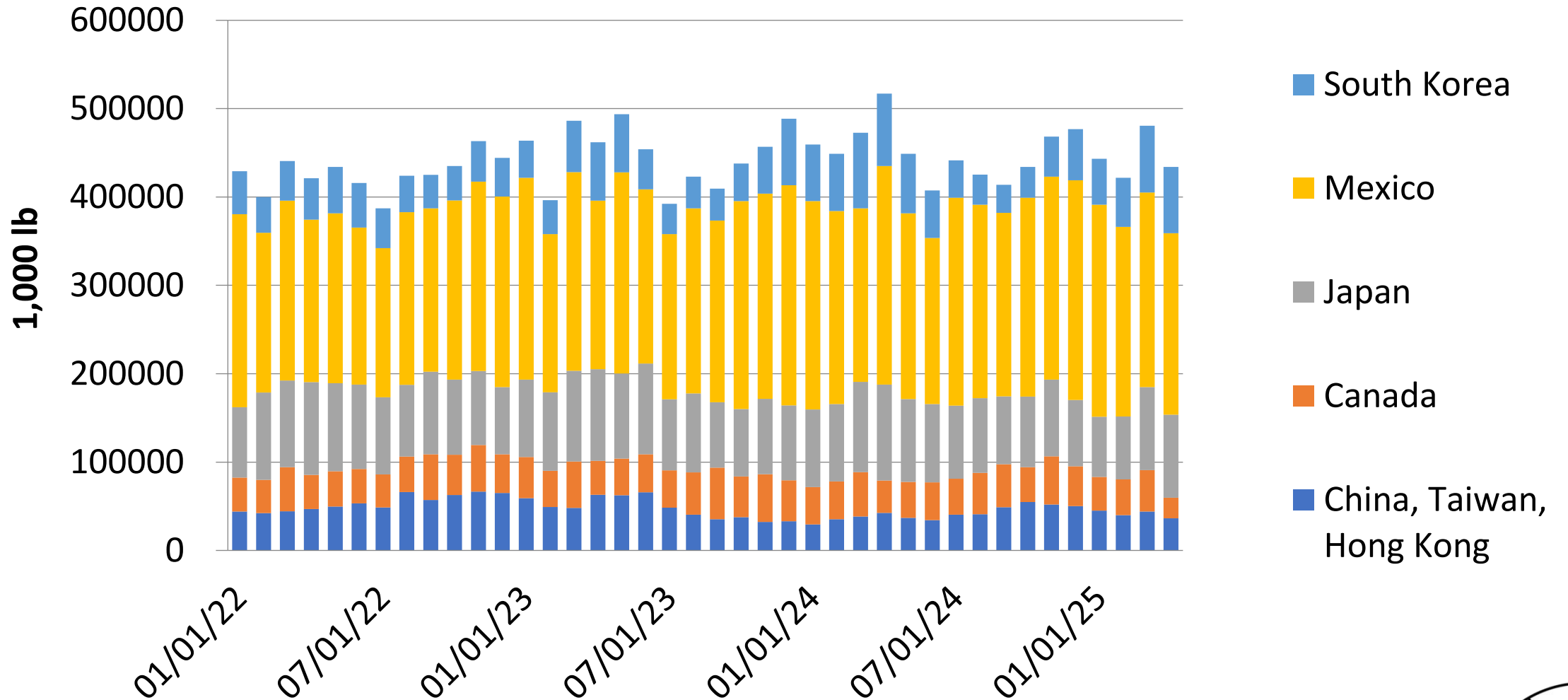
U.S. Annual Per Capita Pork Consumption

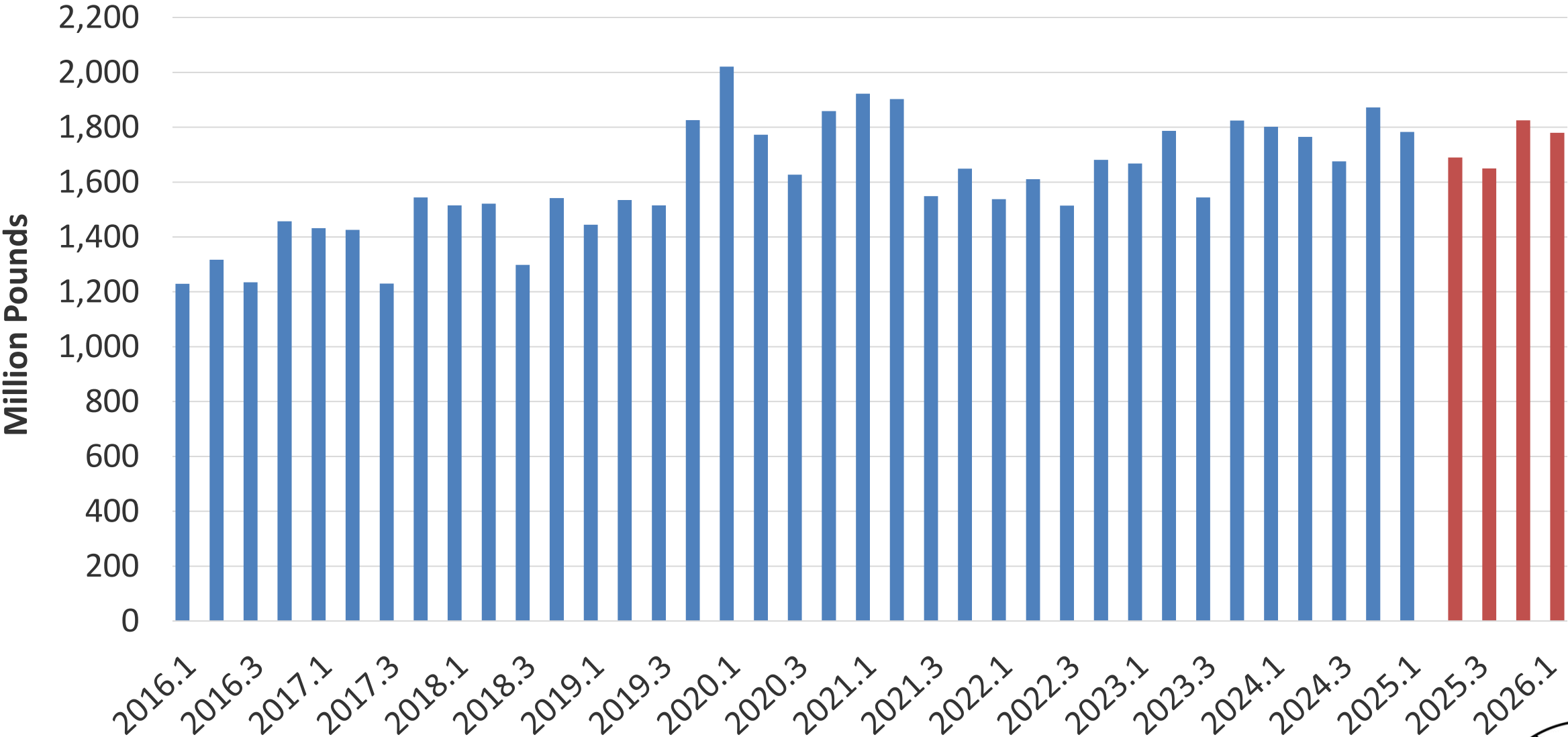
U.S. Pork Exports

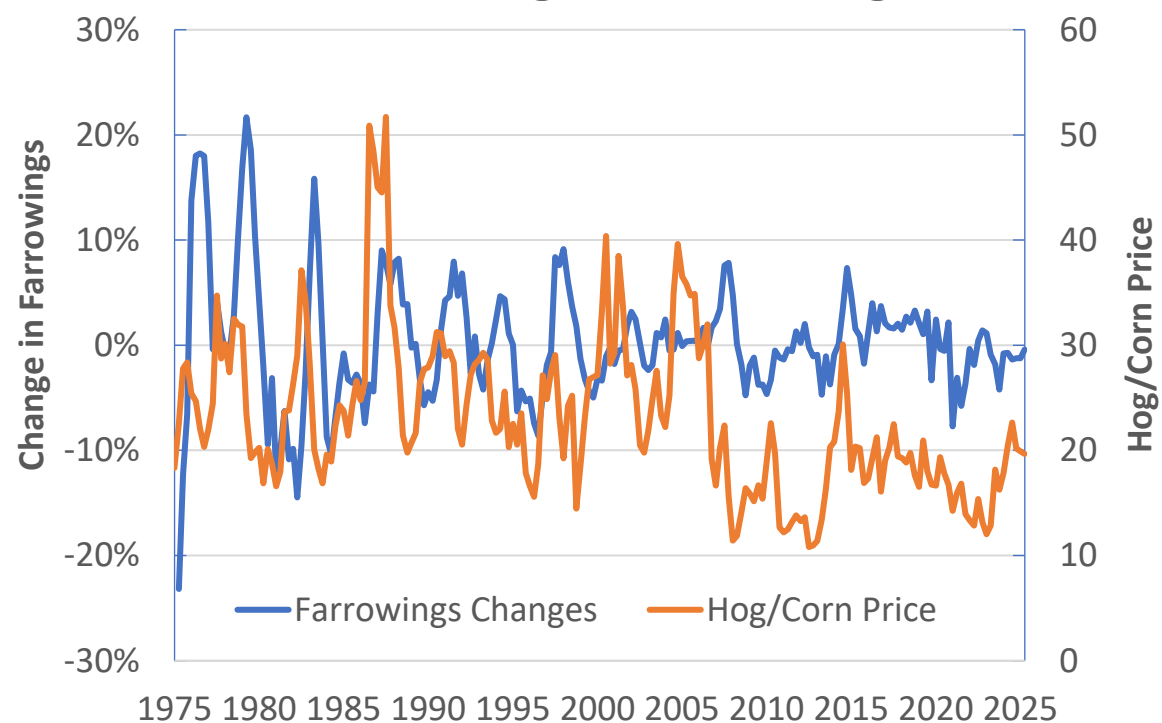

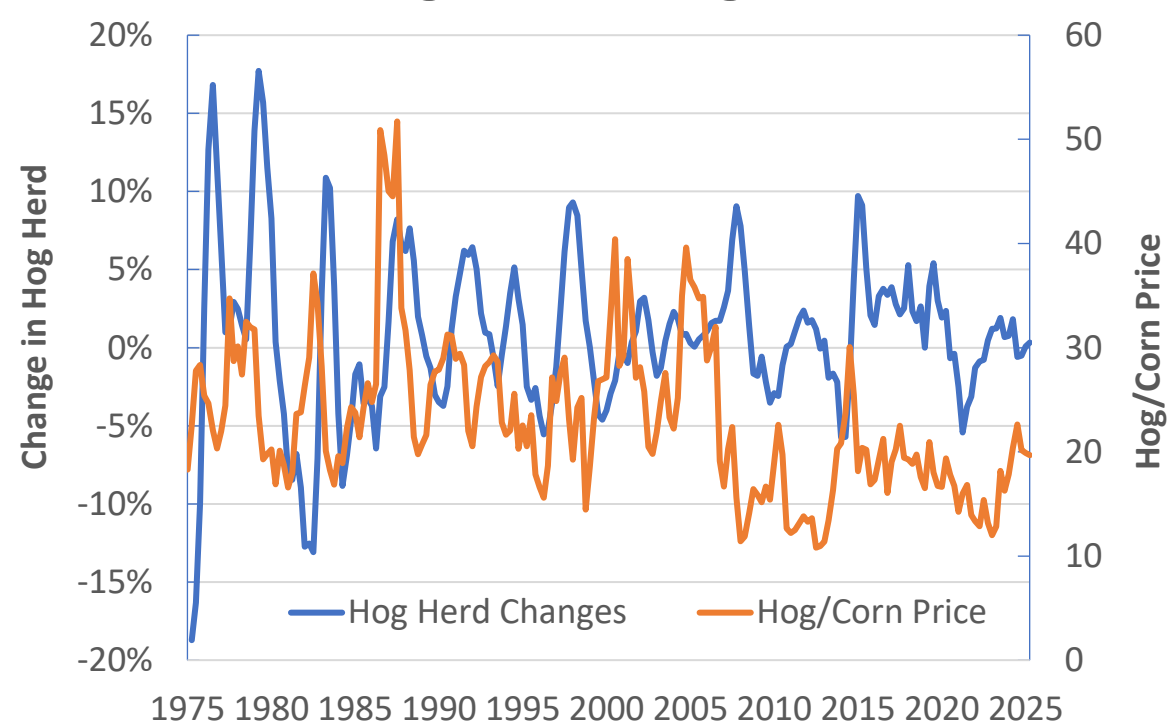


Hog-to-Corn Price Ratio & Production Cycles
