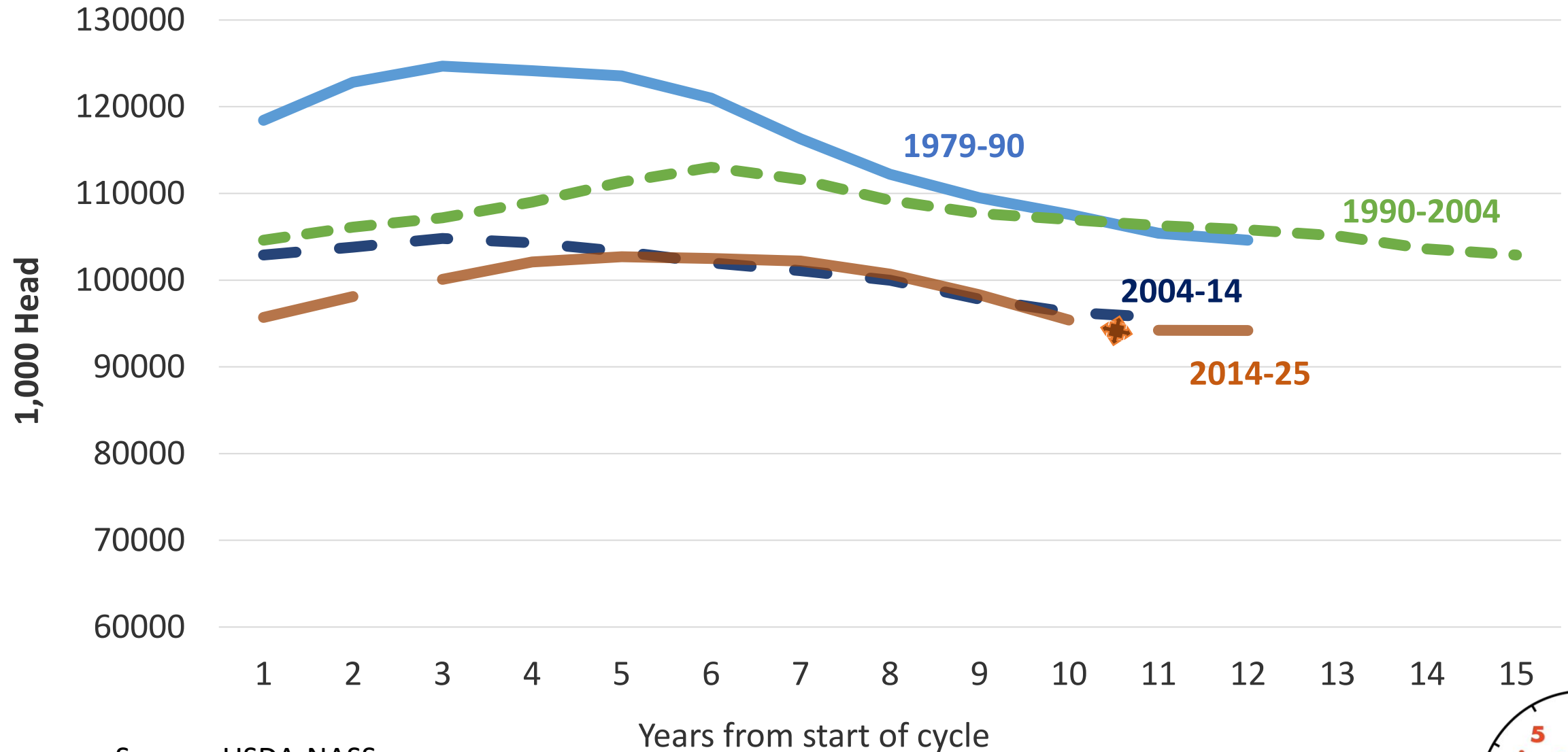

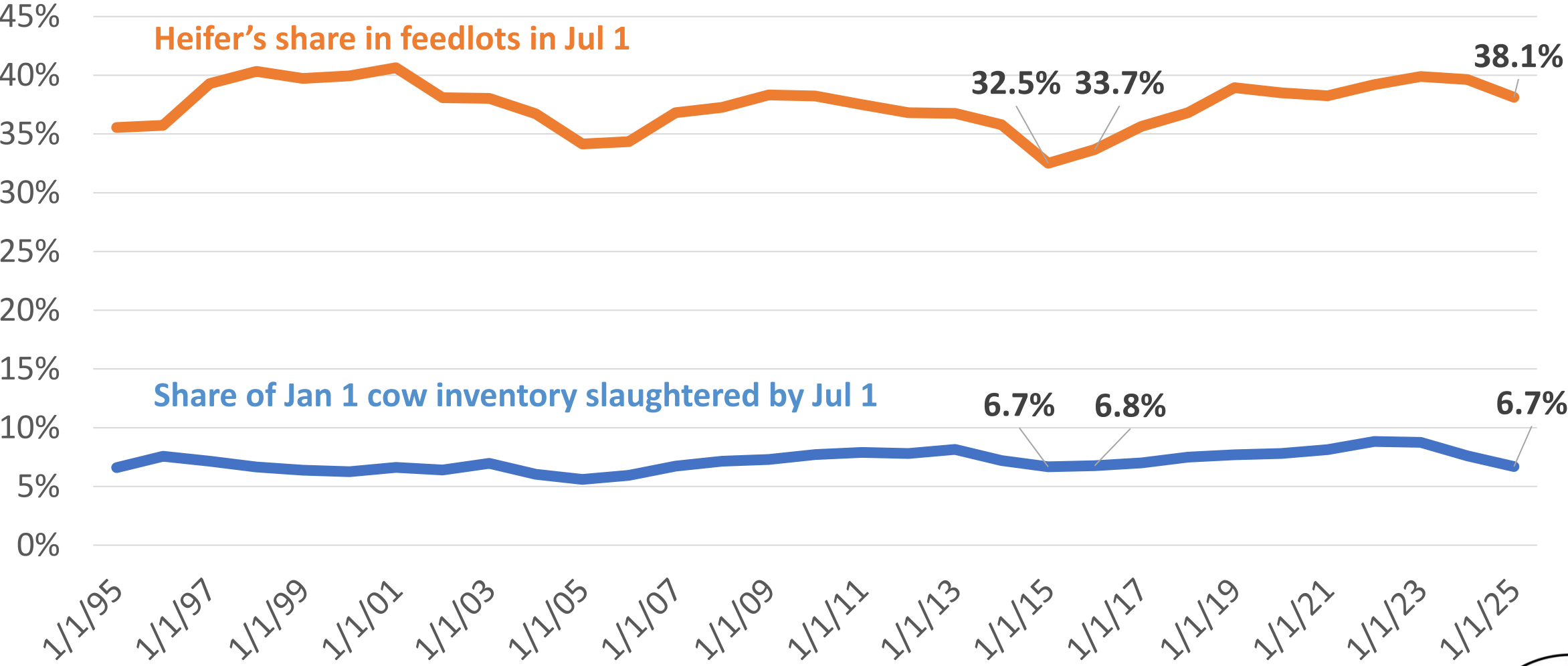

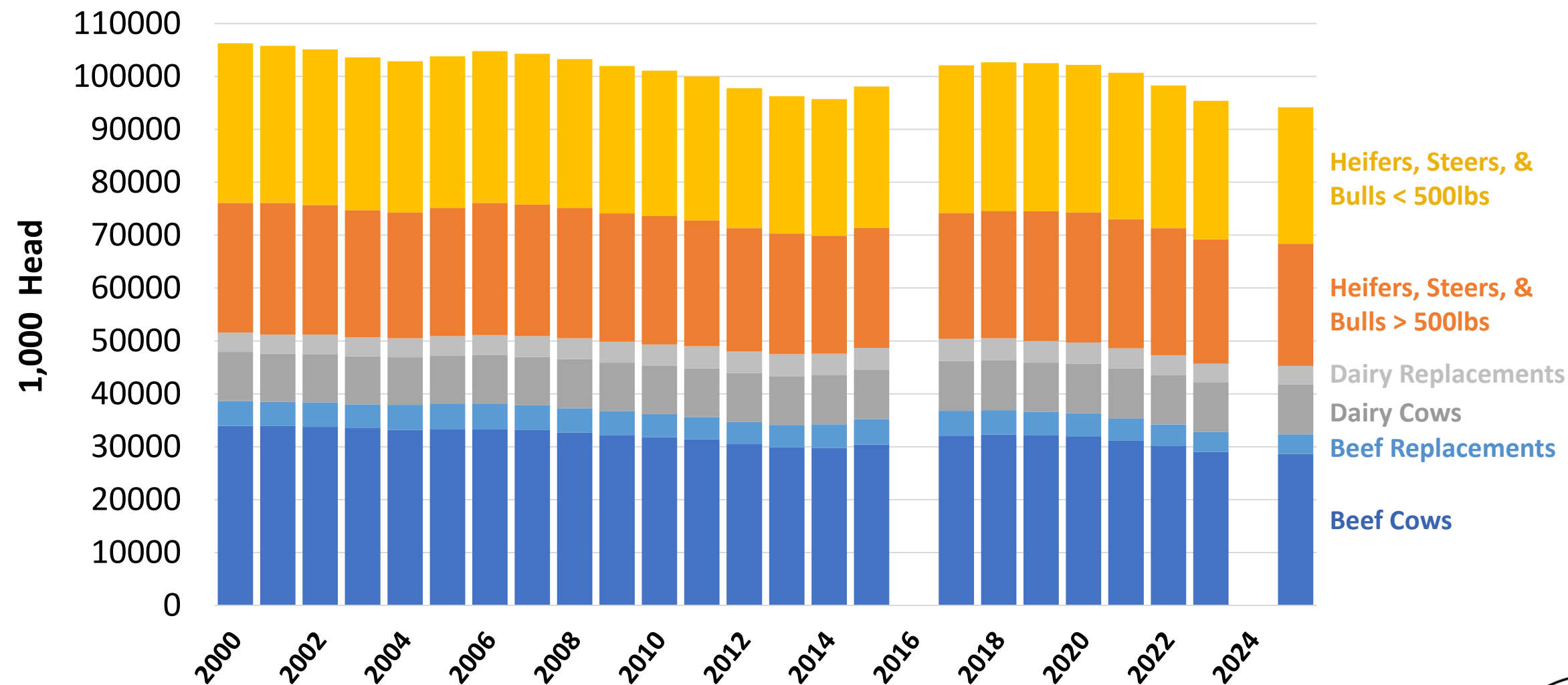
July 1 Inventory of Cattle & Calves in U.S. by Cycles



Indicators of Herd Expansion & Contraction



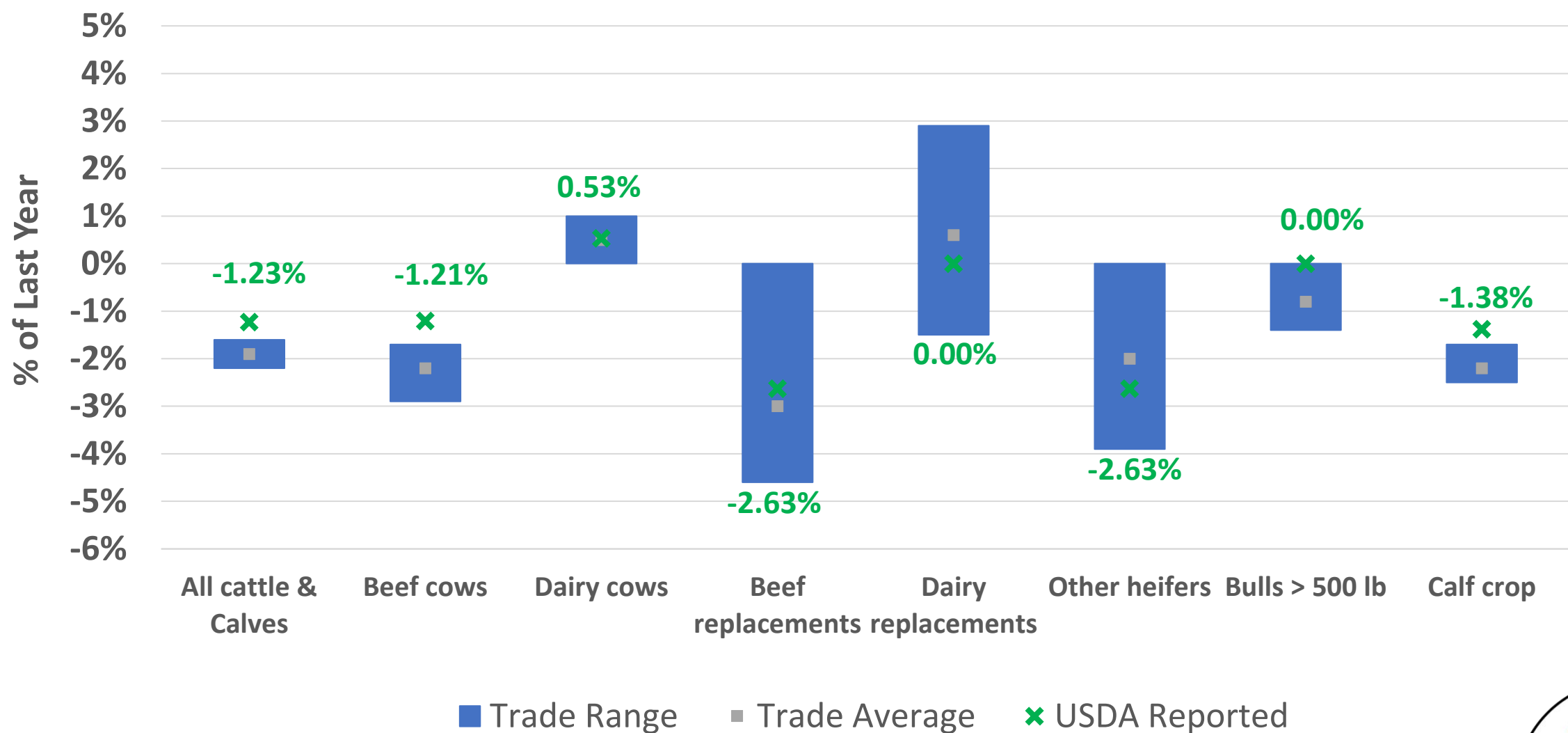

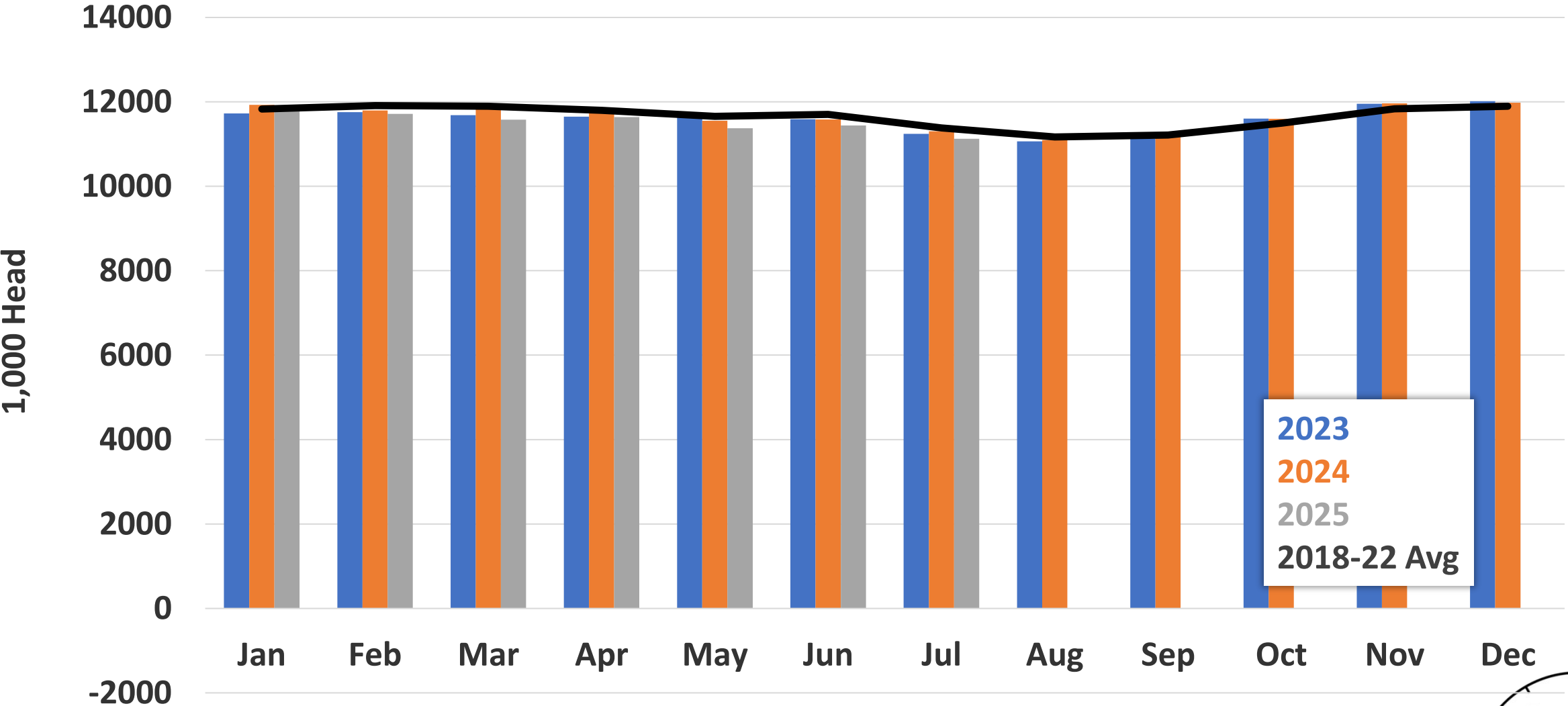
USDA vs. Pre-Report Estimates

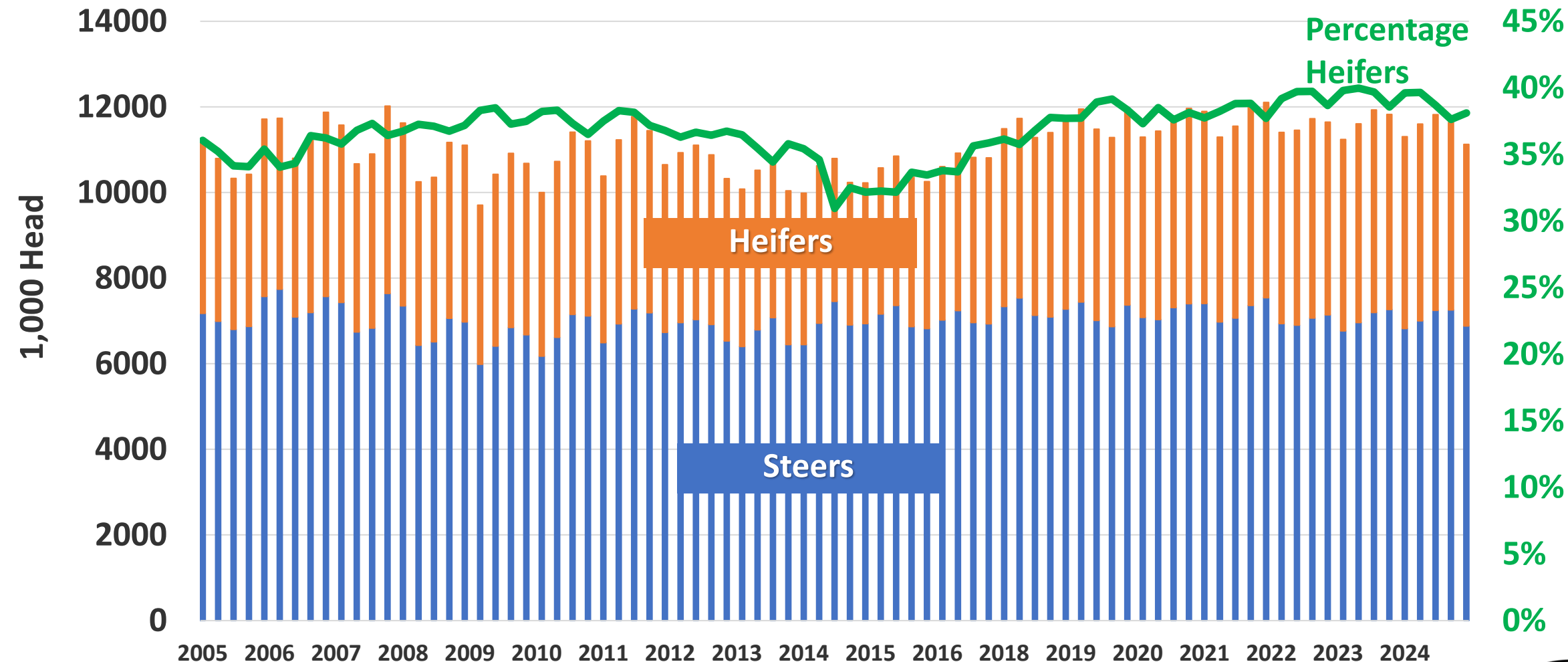
Cattle on Feed in 1,000+ Capacity Feedlots

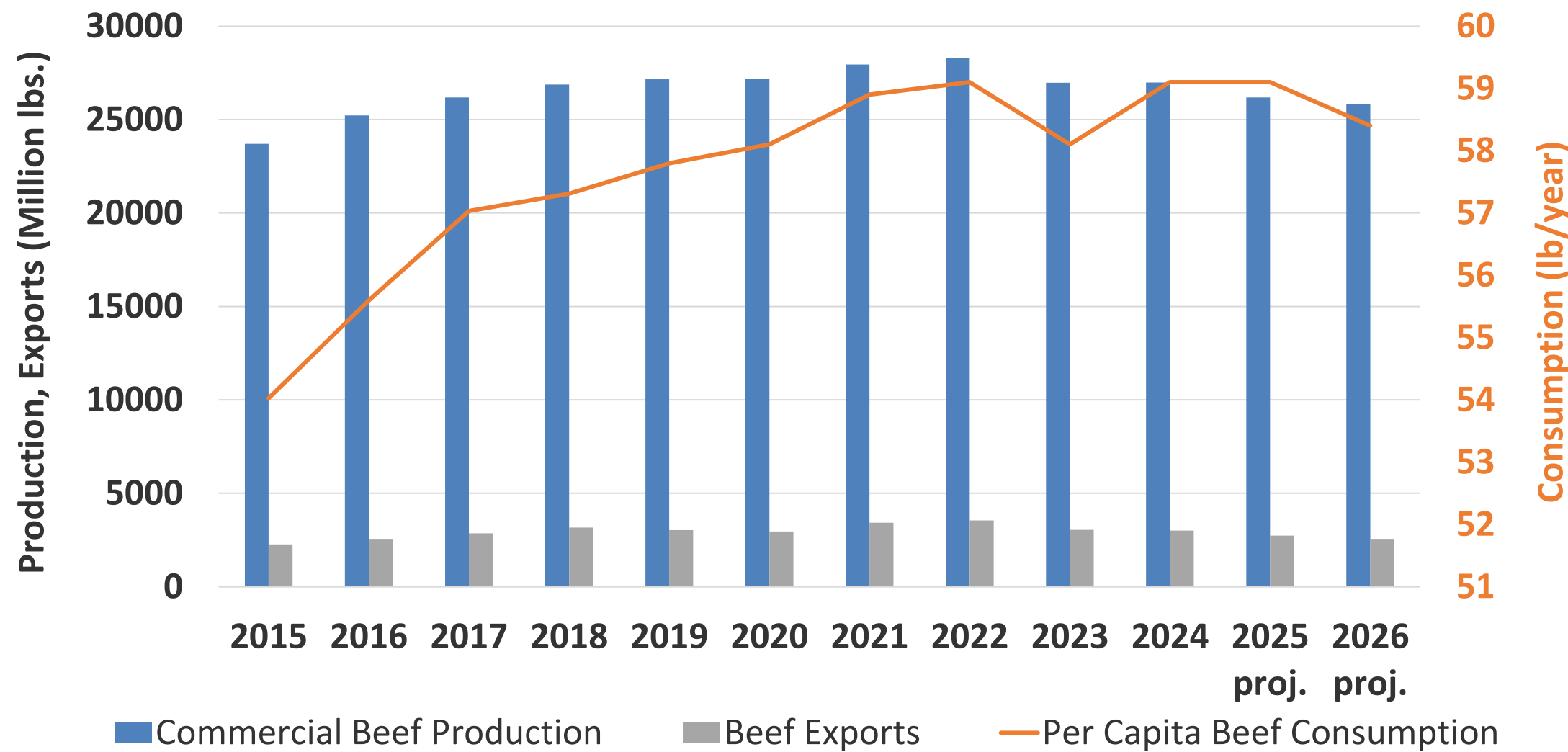

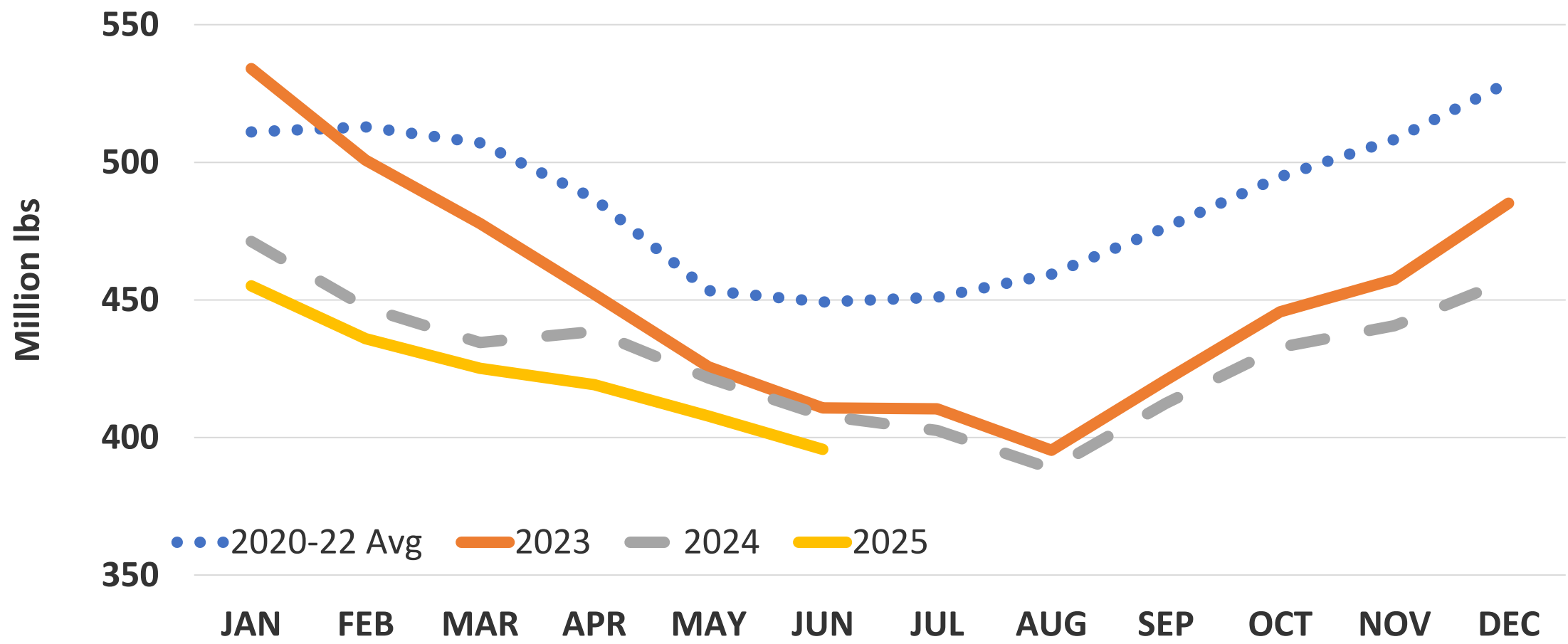
U.S. Beef Production & Disappearance

U.S. Frozen Stocks of Beef at End of Month

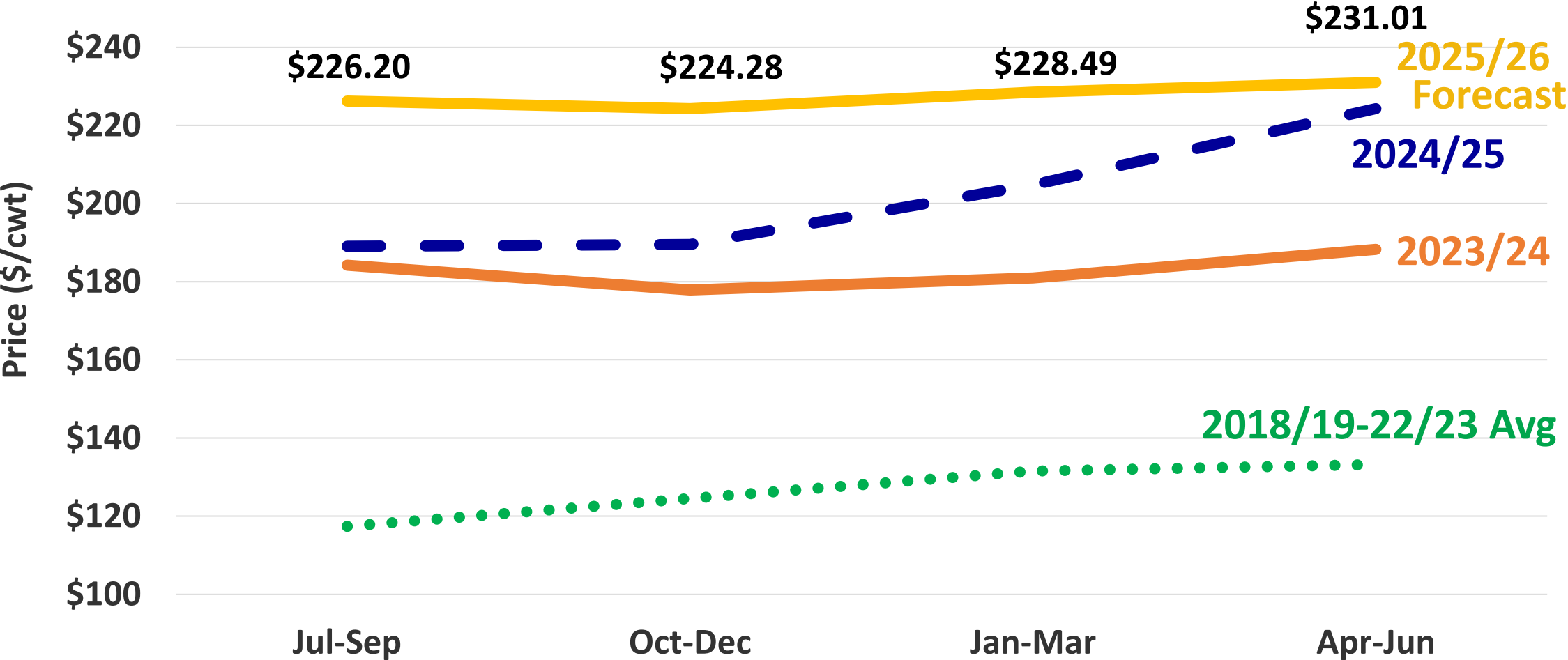

Quarterly Average Slaughter Steer Price

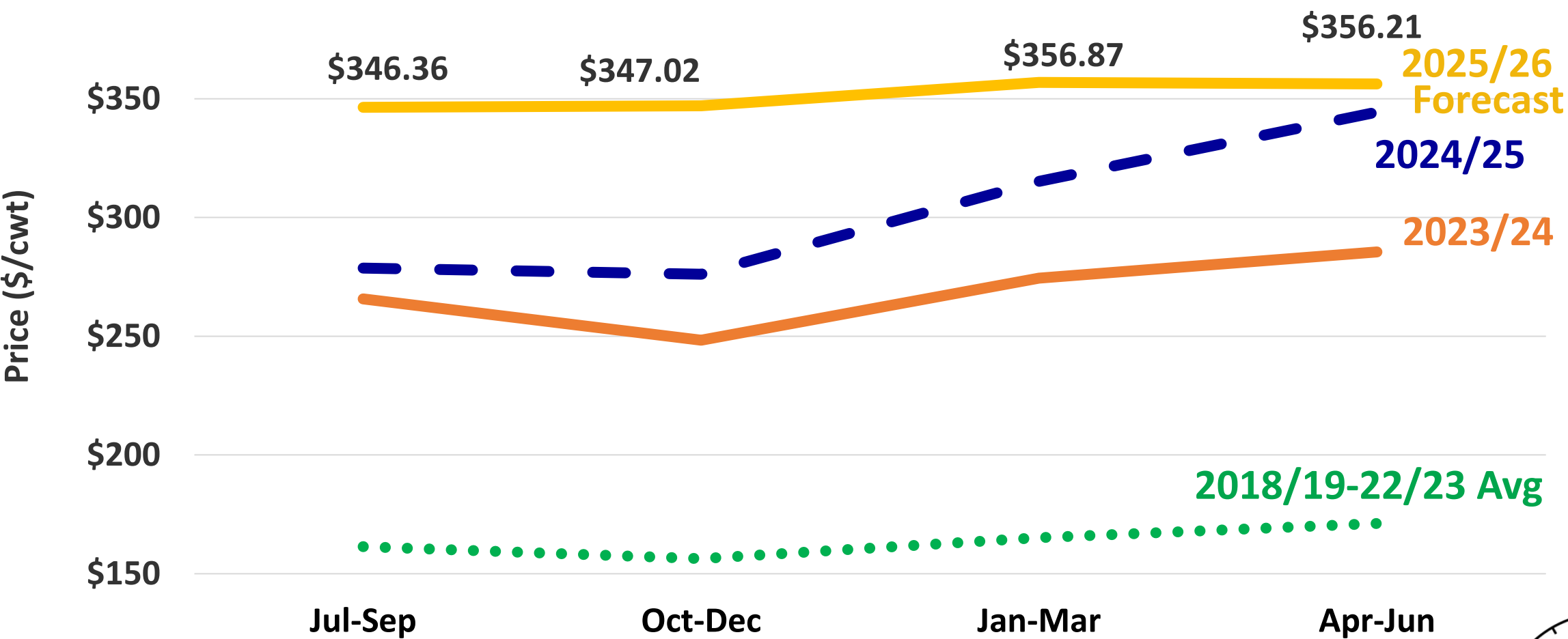
5 Market Weighted Average
